$$\textcircled{1} \quad \frac{1}{4} + \frac{2}{4} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$\textcircled{6} \quad \frac{7}{8} - \frac{3}{8} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$\textcircled{2} \quad \frac{4}{6} - \frac{1}{6} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$\textcircled{7} \quad \frac{1}{6} + \frac{5}{6} = 1$$

$$\textcircled{3} \quad \frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{3} = 1$$

$$\textcircled{8} \quad \frac{2}{8} + \frac{5}{8} = \frac{7}{8}$$

$$\textcircled{4} \quad \frac{3}{4} - \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$\textcircled{9} \quad \frac{5}{9} - \frac{2}{9} = \frac{1}{3}$$

$$\textcircled{5} \quad \frac{3}{7} + \frac{3}{7} = \frac{6}{7}$$
